

Join the movement to “Cross at Kent”

Local residents are petitioning the City of Hamilton to request a Pedestrian-activated stoplight at the corner of Kent and Aberdeen Streets.

Some reasons this stoplight is important:

- **Kent St. is a natural point to cross** – The only street stretching from Amelia to Charlton and it is part way between Queen and Locke Streets.
- **HSR bus stops on both sides of Aberdeen at Kent** with no crossing stoplight.
- **Residents need to cross** - Local schools, the HAAA, Radial and Reservoir green spaces, library and all Locke Street businesses.
- **Aberdeen is not safe for pedestrians** - Narrow sidewalks abut the busy road.
